Speculation ACT Fire Brigade chief has quit

There is speculation that the chief officer of the ACT Fire Brigade, David Prince, has quit.

It comes just a day after the Government announced it would be streamlining the divisions of the Emergency Services Agency (ESA) under two deputy commissioners.

It is understood Mr Prince was in line for one of those positions.

The Opposition's emergency services spokesman Steve Pratt says this is a further indictment on the changes the Government is making to the ESA.

"This is deeply concerning," he said.

"On the back of the loss of Peter Dunne last year and other very experienced officers, this just indicates the Government's emergency management in the ACT is an absolute bloody shambles."
