

ICD-10-AM Clinical Coding Samples

A 45 year old female patient with ductal carcinoma of the left upper breast is admitted for chemotherapy via her POC. In this admission the POC is accessed and loaded. After the chemo a CADD is attached and loaded. The patient was discharged on the same day.

A 54 year old female patient is admitted with an exacerbation of her Rheumatoid arthritis. During the 4 day admission her Type II Diabetes was monitored and she was seen by the dietician. Patient history listed in the admission notes reveals a history of hypertension (Stable on Atenolol).

ICD-10-AM Codes:

M06.99 Rheumatoid arthritis
E11.72 Type 2 Diabetes with features of insulin resistance
I10 Hypertension

A 35 year old female was readmitted to hospital 2 days post discharge with erythema and ooze from her post operative wound site. Previously the patient had an open cholecystectomy performed. Wound infection was documented with positive swabs for Staph aureus. The patient is started on Amoxicillin and discharged after 2 days.
