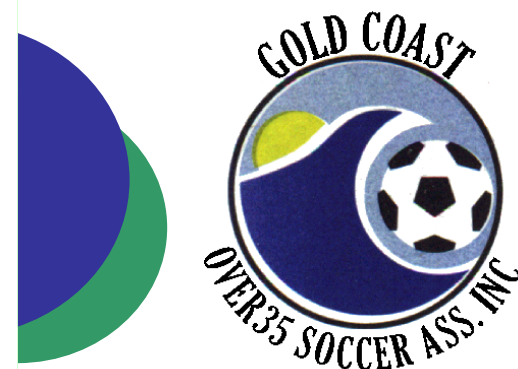

Priorities for Gold Coast Over 35 Soccer Association Inc

Communication Strategic Direction

Priority One

1. Update information on web site regularly
2. Establish positive relationships with Musgrave Soccer Club
3. Establish positive relationships with Gold Coast Soccer Federation
4. Review Role of Team Leaders book

Priority Two

5. Management Committee available to respond to questions
6. Inform members

Priority Three

7. Develop systems for effective two-way communication
8. Continue to display information on noticeboards

Planning and Policy Strategic Direction

Priority One

1. Develop and implement policies for risk management, human resource management, field and facility management
2. Review constitution and make changes where necessary
3. Negotiate Right of Use Agreement with Council for next five years

Priority Two

4. Develop a Risk Management Plan
5. Develop systems for members input into planning processes

Priority Three

6. Identify planning processes and set annual, biennial and five yearly plans
7. Approach business people to assist with planning

Financial Management Strategic Direction

Priority One

1. Set financial goals (budgeting)
2. Aim to make a profit
3. Explore revenue streams

Priority Two

4. Utilise government funding (grants)
5. Investigate ways to reduce expenditure

Priority Three

6. Target organisations for sponsorship

Volunteers Strategic Direction

Priority One

1. Identify and appoint a volunteer coordinator
2. Increase number of volunteers (seek external to the club)
3. Develop a list of tasks and roster one person per task

Priority Two

4. Develop a system of rewarding and recognising volunteers
5. Create relevant sub-committees

Priority Three

6. Develop position descriptions for all roles

Participation/Competition Strategic Direction

Priority One

1. Establish a games committee
2. Player management

Priority Two

3. Develop a representative team to play against other areas
4. Recognise top players, most improved etc

Priority Three

5. Play against other competitions, eg, Brisbane

Facilities Strategic Direction

Priority One

1. Establish a facility management committee with existing users
2. Investigate options to access more fields for competition and training
3. Investigate and discuss with all parties a Right of Use Agreement for Keith Hunt Park fields

Priority Two

4. Explore options for clubhouse, lights, covered area, improved seating and amenities

Priority Three

5. Improve quality of fields
