Active Member	\$620.00

Junior Active Member

A member who on the 31 st December of any year is 18 years of age or under and is an active rower or who satisfies the Club Committee that they intend to become an active rower.	\$620.00
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Adaptive Member

A member who has a recognised permanent disability and who has been or intends to become an active rower.

Part year fees – Full Fee Membership

Joins within the 1 st quarter	100% of fee
Joins within the 2 nd quarter	75 % of fee
Joins within the 3 rd quarter	50 % of fee
Joins within the 4 th quarter	25 % of fee

Note: when 3 or more members of the same family join NSRC as full-fee active members, the 3rd and subsequent members pay 50% of the annual fees.

Support and Associate Membership Types

Coach Member	\$100.00
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A member whether qualified to be a member under any other classification or not, is an experienced rower or qualified rowing coach who exclusively devotes their time to coaching Club members in the techniques of the sport. Generally such a member is not entitled to use the Club's boats or facilities to personally row.

Coxswain Member	\$100.00
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A member whether qualified to be a member under any other classification or

not, who fully devotes their time to the coxing of a crew or crews. Generally such a member is not entitled to use the Club's boats or facilities to personally row.

Associate Member

\$100.00

Member whether qualified to be a member under any other classification or not and has attained the age of 18 years. Generally such member has limited voting rights and is not entitled to use the Club's boats or facilities to personally row.

Other Fees and Charges

Learn to Row Member

\$185.00

A temporary membership granted for 8 weeks for specific structured training program "Learn to Row Program" under the guidance of a Club-appointed coach.

Boat Damage Fee

\$50.00

Contribution to Repairs, payable by all members of the crew in any boat that sustains damage
