PAC Annual General Meeting, 7.30PM, Friday, 20 July 2012

Members' should be aware of the following protocols that are required for the AGM meeting;

(i) Retirement and Election of Directors - Rule 69(b)(i). Nominations for directors shall be sought in writing, signed by a proposer and seconder (each of whom shall be an active member of the co-operative) and the nominee, at least 28 days before the annual general meeting.

(ii) Resolution – Rule 57(c) Any member who has a resolution to submit to a general meeting must give written notice of the terms of the resolution to the co-operative at least 35 days prior to the meeting.

The notice of resolution must specify:

- (a) the intention to propose the resolution as a special resolution at the meeting;
- (b) the reason for making of the special resolution; and
- (c) the effect of the special resolution if passed.
