232. **Dudley Graham CARPENTER** "Sandy" (Arthur, Job, Richard) was born 28 Sep 1924 in Stannum, NSW.

Dudley was accidentally shot through the shin while he and his young brother Barney (Donald) were trying to shoot crows in the corn patch with an old breech loaded .22 raffle. The boys simply washed the wound in creek water and wrapped it in the calico bag used for the corn meat.

Sandy served in the Australian Army for 3 years – refer to the below service record.



Sandy married **Ada Betty JONES** "Betty". Betty died 29 Sep 1984 in Urunga, NSW, age 55.

Dudley Graham Carpenter married Ada Betty Jones after WW2 producing four children, Beryl Ada, Graham Ross, Maree (deceased at 2 years) and Arthur Charles (Butch).

They spent their life raising their family in NSW on the north coast and Sydney, retiring to Urunga in the early 80's, Betty passed away in Urunga in 1984.

Dudley, Graham and Butch still reside in Urunga, NSW whilst Beryl resides in Taree, NSW.
