Fees are \$1 per cage to a maximum of \$15. Juniors pay only 50 cents per cage. Payable prior to benching birds.

All birds to have a closed Aluminium ring and must have been bred by the exhibitor. Young Birds classes to have a purple 2011 and/or a gold 2012 closed ring. Split rings on opposite leg are allowed.

**Stickers & Staging :** To be placed on the bottom left hand side. NSV/NSC birds to have a second sticker on the bottom Right hand side with a description of the bird. All birds to be showed in a standard Show cage complete with an approved seed in the cage. Water may be added to cages before or after judging at the discretion of the exhibitor and/or Show Manager.

**Benching :** All birds to be benched by 8.30am.

**Judges and Judging:** A Ozoux, G Woods, T Bevan.. To commence at 9.15am

**Presentation of Trophies** as soon a practical after completion of judging. **Note: No birds to leave the bench or the hall without approval of the Show Manager.**

**Status :** Open, Intermediate and Novice as graded by the Newcastle Budgerigar Club or Budgerigar Society of NSW. **Note: Novice has been divided into 2 subsections: i.e. 1) Amateur:** Novice exhibitors who are not Juniors or Beginners. **2) Beginner/Junior :** 1st year Novice exhibitors and Juniors who are under 17 years of age and have won less than 6 major Junior Awards.

Old classes for old birds only and are for all statuses combined. Novice, Junior, Beginner and Intermediate exhibitors may enter Old birds in these sections without loss of status.

**Bird Sales :** Exhibitors and members may bring surplus stock birds for sale at the event. Cages must not be overcrowded and contain sufficient food and water. All sales effected at the Show shall be subject to a commission rate to the Club of 10% of the sale price (rounded up to the nearest dollar).

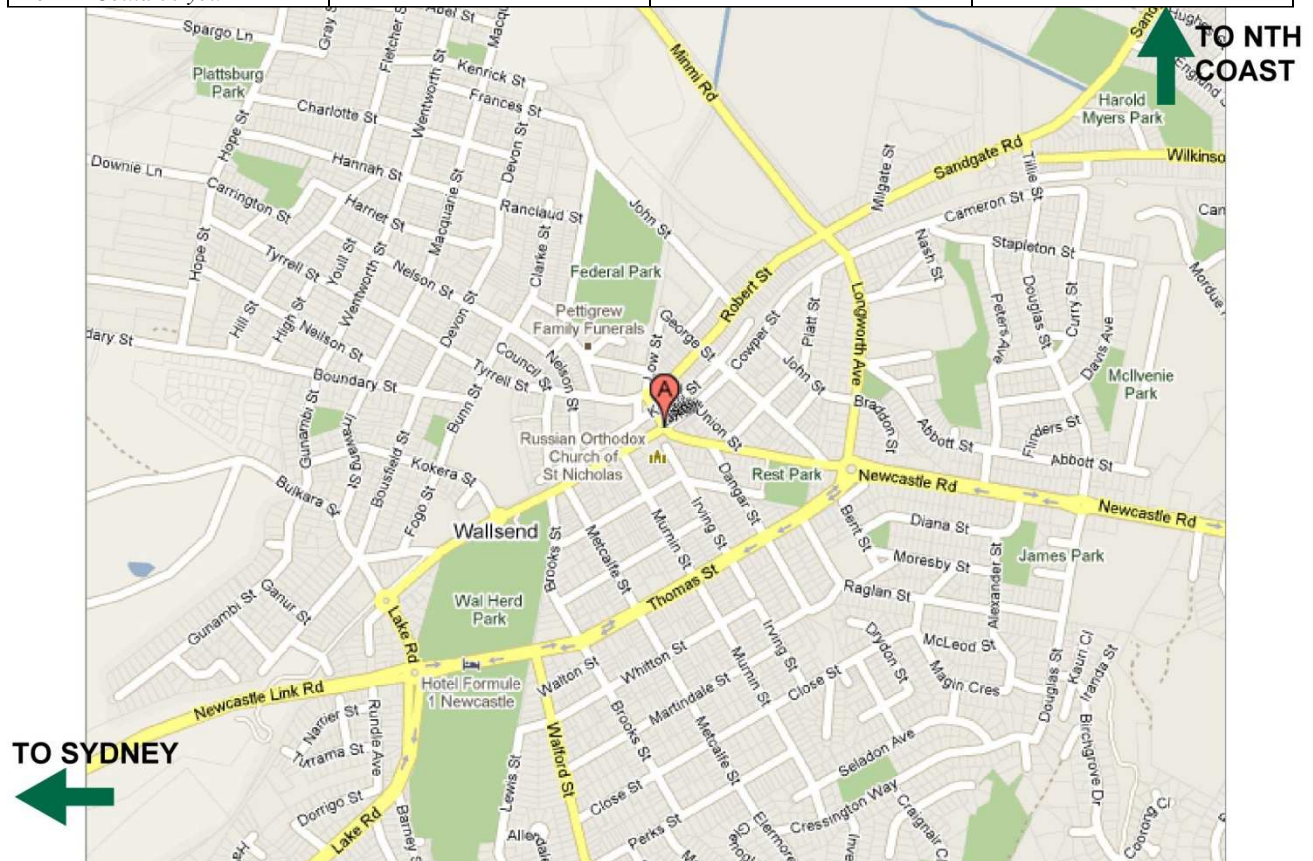
